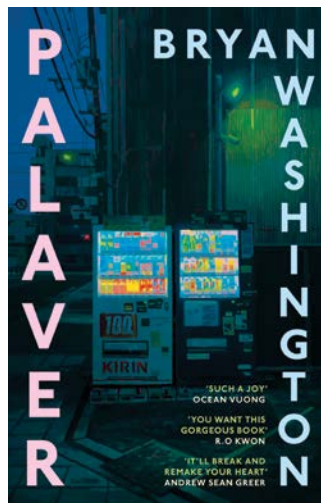
# Palaver

Separated only by the son's cat, they bristle against each other, the mother wrestling with Jamaican memories while the son struggles to forgive her. But, through shared meals and an eventful trip to Nara, both mother and son start to figure out what 'home' really means – and they begin to see if they can find it in each other.
